General Functions:

Under the overall supervision of the Procurement and Logistics Officer and direct supervision of the Logistics Assistant, the successful candidate will be responsible in paying attention and ensuring hygienic standard of sanitary facilities at all the times.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Clean and tidy the office, kitchen, corridors, toilets, and meeting rooms at all the times.
2. Report on the stock status of toilet rolls, soaps, washing liquid etc.
3. Prepare and ensuring that tea, coffee, water and refreshments are served and provided to the staff members, guests during official meetings.
4. Assist in the loading, unloading and movement of furniture, equipment and cargo office supplies.
5. Purchase all the necessary supplies and materials as required.
4. Assist in providing general logistics and procurement support to the office.
6. Execute the small repairs in the office and perform necessary maintenance procedures.
7. Perform such other duties as may be assigned.

- Consistently approaches work with energy and a positive and constructive attitude;
- Proven ability to responds positively to critical feedback.
