### **OCTOBER 2023 HIGHLIGHTS**

#### TÜRKİYE



- Supported 84 skilled individuals in Adiyaman and Sanliurfa to establish or recover their micro/ small businesses, including through grants, training and mentorship aimed at enhancing income generation
- Organized a hackathon in coordination with the Sahinbey Municipality, Gaziantep Chamber of Industry, Gaziantep University, and Teknopark, aimed at addressing labour market integration challenges for migrants and refugees



- Reached 6,176 beneficiaries with lifesaving primary healthcare services, through partners Medicine de Monde Türkiye (DDD) in Hatay and Doctors Worldwide Türkiye (YYD) in Adiyaman, Kahramanmaras and Malatya
- Supported the Ministry of Health's medical mobile units with 15 vehicles in 9 cities, providing 20,640 medical services since July
- Conducted workshop with partners covering priority topics on healthcare in emergencies



- Continued efforts to build capacities of non-protection sector teams to mainstream protection principles in their work, especially to strengthen case referral
- Distributed 485 solar lamps to informal and formal settlements and remote villages in Adiyaman
- Continued co-chairing all MHPSS coordination mechanisms and at national and four hub levels



- Delivered 150 shelter containers to Adiyaman, in coordination with the Disaster and Emergency Management Authority (AFAD)
- Delivered 50 accessible containers to Adıyaman (10), Hatay (10), Kahramanmaraş (20) and Malatya (10), specially designed to meet the needs of people with disabilities
- Provided 29 days of rental assistance to 172 individuals
- · Provided baby diapers, food, and clothing to 17 individuals in Sanliurfa



- Conducted briefing on winterization priorities, key sector updates, introduction to the UN Earthquake Solutions and Mobility Analysis Team (ESMAT) and overview of formal sites
- Provided inputs to the intersectoral winterization plan led by the UN Area-Based Coordination
   Team
- · Joined multi-sectoral assessment in Adiyaman
- Conducted visits with authorities in Hatay and Adiyaman to inform site improvement projects
- 3,000 families and 12,000 individuals reached by sector partners through mobile activities in 241 sites (informal), including awareness raising, information dissemination, needs profiling and referral
- 251 referrals made by sector partners to different sectors, including Health, Protection, Shelter/NFI and WASH
- 680 fire safety kits distributed by sector partners to 15,969 individuals / 4,154 families



- Delivered 425 water tanks to Adiyaman, Gaziantep and Malatya
- Conducted site visits in Hatay to inform support to informal settlements
- Ongoing procurement of 20,000 hygiene kits, 2,000 baby kits, 5,000 menstrual kits, 20 water filtration units, 60 disabled-friendly toilets, 32 combo toilets, 536 single toilets and 315 single showers



#### **NORTHWEST SYRIA**



- 88,350 individuals in 56 IDP sites benefited through the provision and coordination of camp management activities, aimed at improving services and living conditions through care and maintenance
- 112 Accountability to Affected Populations (AAP) sessions conducted by implementing
- MANAGEMENT (CCCM) 168 awareness raising sessions on fire safety preparedness and response conducted by implementing partners



 Commenced beneficiary verification for cash-for-work and business development support initiatives in coordination with implementing partners



- 21,680 individuals / 4,501 households supported through cash-based interventions by implementing partners
- 4,329 individuals / 779 households supported through cash-for-nutrition by implementing
- 11,626 individuals / 2,290 households supported through e-vouchers



- 6,982 individuals benefitted from medical consultations at an IOM-supported hospital, including 51 emergency dialysis sessions, 37 cardiac catheterization referrals and 46 ICU admissions
- 868 children supported, including 187 pediatric surgery admissions
- 523 women received maternity and gynecology services
- 7,385 outpatient consultations through IOM-supported hospitals
- 1,865 individuals received health education through qualified community health workers



- 8,790 individuals reached through MHPSS activities and child protection case management, with a focus on unaccompanied and separate children
- · Continued provision of individual protection assistance, legal counselling and referrals to specialized and non-specialized services through mobile teams, static community centres, child-friendly spaces and 11 help desks



- 72 camps supported with emergency WASH services by implementing partners
- 100,075 individuals benefitted from water trucking, desludging and solid waste management
